This remarkable journey will begin in the bustling capital city of Beijing. Spend a day walking through Tiananmen Square, exploring the Forbidden City, Temple of Heaven and the Summer Palace, and viewing the pandas at the Beijing Zoo. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner of succulent Beijing Duck with your fellow travelers. Day two in Beijing will find you wandering from the Mutianyu section of the Great Wall of China, to The Sacred Way and finally the Dalai Lama Temple where you will gain a great appreciation for the rich history of China. You will then be able to immerse yourself in the Chinese culture during your Hutong Tour before setting off to Xian.

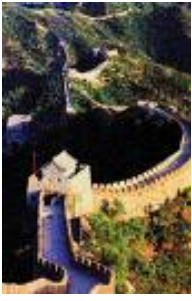
In Xian, you will be treated with a Dynasty Show and Five Star accommodations at the Hyatt Hotel. In the morning, you will be off to see the world famous Terra Cotta Warriors, the Huaqing Hot Spring and the City Wall. Following breakfast on day two in Xian, you will visit one of only two remaining Tang Dynasty pagodas, the Wild Goose Pagoda. The Forest of Steles and Museum will be your last site before heading to the home of the beloved pandas.

From Chengdu, you will travel by van to Ya'an City and on to Bifengxia for volunteer registration. After a restful night at the Ya'an Ibis Hotel, you will head to the Bifengxia Panda Center for two full days with the pandas. You will be able to work with the staff at the Center and see first hand the huge impact your donations have made in the lives of the resident pandas. Tai Shan will be in his new home on top of Leopard Mountain and available for viewing and photographing. Suzanne will be on hand to meet you and share her experiences with you. On the last night at Bifengxia, Suzanne will discuss the conservation efforts of Pandas International during a dinner at the Center. There will be plenty of opportunities to photograph the pandas, including the chance to hold and be photographed with one cub, playtime in the kindergarten with the young cubs will also be on the agenda during your time at the Center. If time permits, you will get the chance to visit the Chengdu Giant Panda Research Center, new home of Mei Lin before heading to Shanghai.

The final destination city on the tour will be the vibrant city of Shanghai. You will enjoy the grand accommodations at the Shanghai Hengsheng Peninsula International Hotel during your last days in China. Your time in Shanghai will include a tour of the Yu Garden, the Bund, the Jade Buddha Temple, and world class Shanghai Museum. The historic French Concession and Chinese Market are also on the agenda.

Enjoy a day trip from Shanghai to the "Venice of China," Suzhou. You will leave Shanghai by train to see the Lingering Garden built 400 years ago, as well as the Garden of Net Master, Embroidery Institute. Your day in Suzhou will also feature a boat trip on the Grand Canal before returning to Shanghai for the evening.

After breakfast, you will have a free morning in Shanghai before heading to the airport for your return to the United States.

where your guide will assist you to the 5 star Hyatt Hotel. In the
evening, you will enjoy the Dynasty Show & Dumpling dinner.(B,D)
- 09/21 Xian A exciting day touring the Terra Cotta Warriors, Huaqing Hot
Spring, and the City Wall. Overnight stay at Hyatt Hotel. (B,L)
- 09/22 Chengdu After breakfast, visit the historic Wild Goose Pagoda & Forest of
Steles Museum. Transfer to the airport for afternoon flight to
Chengdu Upon arrival, you will meet and drive straight to
Bifengxia Panda Reserve, check in to the Panda Club for volunteer
registration and return to Ya'an city to stay overnight at the
Ya'an Ibis Hotel. (B,D)
- 09/23 Bifengxia Spend first full day volunteering with the pandas at Bifengxia.
Suzanne Braden, Director of Pandas International, will be on hand
to share her experiences. There will be time to take pictures with
the young pandas. (Fees included in tour) (B,L,D)
- 09/24 Bifengxia Enjoy another full day volunteering at the Panda Center gaining
new knowledge of the panda. Tai Shan, born at the National Zoo,
will be on display to watch and photograph. In the evening,
Suzanne will discuss the conservation efforts of Pandas
International during dinner. (B,L,D)
- 09/25 Chengdu Following breakfast and check out, spend the morning on the
Reserve Tour & have your photo taken with one panda. Travel to
Chengdu in the afternoon by van. If time permits, you will visit
Chengdu Panda Research Institute, new home of Mei Lin before
catching an evening flight to Shanghai. Meet guide & transfer to
Shanghai Hengsheng Peninsula International Hotel. (B,L)
